What	In this beginner's level gold work class students will work on a silk thread daisy with gold thread accents. Students will work with several gold threads including pearl purl, smooth purl, bright check purl and Japan gold plus others. Techniques include couching, chipping, and beading with gold threads, plunging threads, outlining with gold thread and working satin stitch with silk thread. The result is a simple yet beautiful piece that hopefully may spur you on to more complicated gold work.
